Chanda and John are succeeding by tackling their addictions together.

Not every recovery program will let couples address their addiction issues together. While many insist on splitting the couple up to work on their individual problems, Wayside believes it's healthier to let the couple fight their fights together. And the couples themselves agree.

Take Chanda and John, for example. They came to Wayside from another Kentucky town. When they did their research for a recovery program, they chose Wayside for FIVE main reasons: (1) it got them out of their town, where all the problems started, (2) it offered a work program to teach them how to work without drugs or alcohol, (3) it taught recovery through many different ways, (4) it offered ongoing support beyond 90 days, and (5) they could go through the program together.

"There are a lot of places that don't accept couples," Chanda says. "They separate them; women at one side and men on the other side. I mean you need that support."

John jumps in, "It's better to be together because I got somebody to talk to at the end of the day, somebody to study with. I can quiz her and she can quiz me and that helps us beat it in our head. I encourage most couples to come. I mean, if they're willing to really do the work."
